Who can attend this event?

As this tour will cover topics that are not appropriate for young children, this event is for attendees that are ages 10 and older only. It is at the parent's discretion if the tour is appropriate for their child, but this event is intended to be fun, interesting, and a little bit spooky. Give us a call if you're on the fence.

Will this tour be indoors or outdoors?

Both! Obviously, weather could impact the planned stops around the downtown Greenville area, but *plan* to walk outdoors for approximately 30-40 minutes. And while walking is limited, comfortable shoes are encouraged.

Where do we meet?

Please use the Museum's free parking lot (accessible from Atwood Street). Upon arrival, check-in with the front desk. The tour will begin at 4:00 p.m. on the first-floor main lobby. We will head off-site at approximately 4:15 p.m., so be sure to arrive on time! And remember, advance registration is required. The address for the Museum is:
